Activity:

Animal life cycle - Frog

Type:

Individual

Age:

 $\overline{3\frac{1}{2}}$ years onwards (Exercise 1), 5 \frac{1}{2} years onwards (Exercise 2)

<u>Material</u>: Make frieze for a life story of a frog. Picture should show the egg, tadpole, a frog with long tail, a frog with a shorter tail and front legs and finally an adult frog. Have another set of the same picture. However, do not make it into a frieze. Use it as a matching card.

Procedure:

Exercise 1

- 1. Lay out the frieze on the floor.
- 2. Discuss the picture with the child.
- 3. Invite him to describe what is happening in each picture.
- 4. Lay out the frieze on the floor.
- 5. The child uses the matching card and matches it to the control frieze.

Exercise 2

- Give the matching card.
- Ask him to place it on the floor in order of sequence.
- Give him the control frieze to check his answer.
